

MUD MADNESS SHEFFIELD RELAUNCHED FOR 30TH MARCH 2019

in support of BlueBell Wood Children's Hospice

Following the driest summer in 50 years, Sheffield's inaugural Mud Madness event has been relaunched for Spring 2019 due to the lack of mud and water at Hesley Wood Scout Activity Centre.

Organisers and the venue felt the event wouldn't deliver the "Mud Madness" experience required, so have relaunched the date for Saturday 30th March 2019.

"We'd like to apologise to all the entrants for postponing this year's Mud Madness but it's due to measures beyond our control. We need to make sure that our first event has the right conditions and the depletion of the lake and the very dry nature of the entire woods, meant we wouldn't have been able to create the muddy experience that we promised", stated Yuri Matischen, from MLS, who are organising the event.

The event will continue to support Bluebell Wood Children's Hospice and all entries will either be transferred to the March event or refunded as required.

Helen Mower, from Bluebell Wood said; "Although we've all enjoyed such a hot summer, the conditions weren't right for this event. We're hoping for a normal winter and spring-like conditions for next year's event, so that our supporters are ready to scramble through mud at Hesley Woods, in what will be a very unique event for the charity and for Sheffield."

All entrants will be contacted directly by MLS this week. The event is open to the entire family and has a Family derivative (entries from 11 years plus) and an adult course, all staged in the Hesley Wood Scout Activity Centre in Chapeltown, Sheffield.

The venue and entry fees will remain the same for 2019, but the **early bird offer** will now be **extended to 31st December 2018**, with all entries that have been made at full price, refunded in line with the early bird fee.
